What do you do after creating ultraluxe interiors from California to Kuwait? If you're **Colacion Studio**, you hit the high seas. The Long Beach-based boutique design firm has recrafted its first megayacht, the \$21 million M/Y 360°. This 155-foot vessel bespeaks the same classic styling and refined touches as the firm's land-based work. The difference here is intimacy—every square inch is considered.

"The sequence of spaces in a superyacht is naturally much smaller than that of a home," says Principal Yvonne Colacion. "This is careful choreography, with a strong initial impact followed by luscious details."

This up-close approach is on display throughout the

boat, from the elaborate main salon to each of its three sleek lounge decks. But the designer went overboard in the owner's master suite. The starburst Macassar Ebony headboard shines against deco-inspired Phoenix Day sconces, while the custom bedding was fabricated by Lyon-based Ateliers Charles Jouffre. And the radiance doesn't stop there. Tucked into the suite is a lounge area, as well as a private sauna, Jacuzzi tub, steam shower and workout space. The space is a pleasure cruise unto itself.

The redesign retained the yacht's existing layout, but transformed it with pure sensuality. "This is elegance, not opulence," says Colacion. "You want to experience the pure comfort of the space again and again." —*Jack Skelley*
