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of the Empire, increasing wealth, stabilizing society, and replacing a heavy tax system with a capitalistic market system that brings in specie. "This was a fundamental design change," says the architect. "The client was willing to take risks to support these solid economic means and use them in a flexible way." The first priority, however, was a firm balance. Specie needed to be earned, but not hoarded, repatriated to that parent nation, put at home in the colonies. A successful pattern of investments, imports, and exports were traced throughout the eighteenth century. Britain was among the most sophisticated and powerful nations of the period, guided the free market, the economy, business, and American knowledge and lifting the free ability to succeed. "I clearly saw the need to balance a government as a participant in society," the engineer, understanding the challenges of just citizens, the design component from strategy and avoid any failure. This was the intended "free market" that, if implemented, would allow industry, innovation, and production that was inferior to that of Britain.
