SUSTAINABLE CHIC

Boston's Macallen Building shows just how chic sustainable can be. The eleven-story condominium building, developed by Pappas Enterprises, is the first high-rise residence in New England that is certified LEED Gold. The building's design takes advantage of abundant natural light and incorporates many green materials, including bamboo floors, recycled quartz countertops and Formica cabinets. Pappas Miron Designs created the luxurious interiors for this model unit, which feature environmentally friendly fabrics from Q Collection and re-upholstered vintage furniture. Sculptural pieces highlight the open, airy space. Natural materials were used whenever possible, such as the large Noguchi paper lantern that hangs above a dining set from Machine Age Furnishings in nearby South Boston. The loft's amazing city views are unhampered by window treatments.
