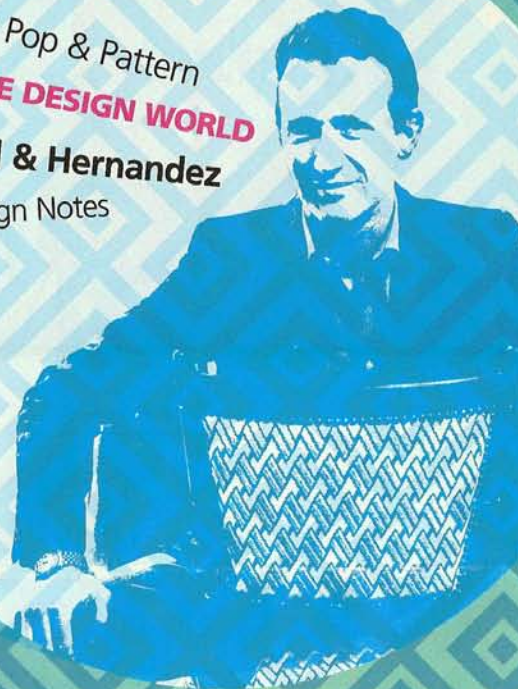

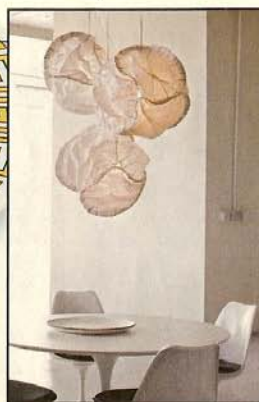
Adler Eats

Made of black lacquer, crystal and bronze, the collection includes a spectacular double folding screen with crystal stud nails (\$40,000), in addition to traditional Japanese candlesticks, four crystal vases with gold engravings representing the four seasons and a crystal Buddha on a lacquered base inspired by a 12th-century antique.
