Pull A Wheel-y

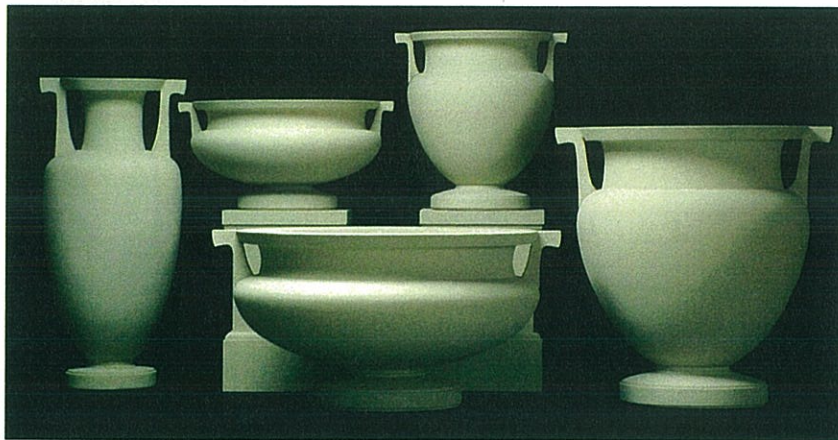
