



Renesting Instinct

Atlanta-based designer Amy Morris did something special for her parents after all their children left home: She created a private sitting room next to their bedroom by closing off the space from a foyer. Then she set about updating it into a tailored, sophisticated sanctuary.

- 1. Charcoal walls create a graphic contrast to the adjacent white bedroom, making the room feel intimate and cocoonlike.
- 2. "Simplifying anything adds a level of elegance," says Morris, who streamlined the detailing of the former pine paneling.
- 3. Texture here is specific. Wool, "which my parents always wear," she says, dresses the ottoman and windows.
- 4. Mixing her parents' heirloom secretary with a new chair and ottoman gives the older piece a fresh look.
