More than two decades after setting up shop, Doug Reynolds' custom handcrafted houses have left an indelible mark on the North Shore. "The balancing of art, science and emotion has always been at the heart of my love of architecture," says Reynolds Architecture Design and Construction founder Doug Reynolds (reynoldsarchitecture.com). He has become known on the North Shore for his classic homes, which boast handcrafted millwork, barrel ceilings and other bespoke details. "Even the most impressive finishes won't be successful if they are applied to a room that feels awkward from the beginning," he explains. "Our clients often comment that, besides being beautiful, our homes feel solid, precisely detailed and comfortable." After a busy 2015-including a 12,000 sq. ft. home in Barrington Hills-this year looks even more hectic with at least eight new homes on his docket plus building a 12-unit apartment building in Evanston. "The North Shore is an incredible place to be an architect," he says. "The waterfront properties, ravines and availability of large country lots allow us to create some incredibly beautiful residences." According to Reynolds, designing a house that feels as good as it looks involves careful consideration of zoning restrictions, lot constraints and the desires of his clients. "It is my job to balance these elements and design a solution that responds to all of them," he says. "We love what we do, and I hope that resonates with people." -TG
