^ LIGHTEN UP WITH GLASS DOORS

Adding a window is expensive but replacing a door can be surprisingly affordable. Choose one with sidelights or frosted glass to enhance light without losing privacy.

< LIGHTEN UP WITH REFLECTIONS

To amplify the natural light in a room, hang a large mirror across from a favorite view, or place furniture with a high-gloss finish near a window, where it will catch the light.
