in chief Anna Wintour and fashion star Jason Wu are among their fans). Having accumulated experience in all the right places—he worked for Jeffrey Bilhuber, she for Stephen Sills—the couple founded their small Manhattan firm in 2005 and have established a reputation for spicing the appropriate with the strikingly unusual.
